MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 99-005 Series of 1999

AN ORDINANCE PRESCRIBING RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE TRANSPORT PERMIT FROM THE OFFICE OF THE MUNICIPAL MAYOR ON THE NATURAL RESOURCES LIKE MINERAL ORE, SAND AND GRAVEL, SOILS AND GUANO, MAJOR AND MINOR FOREST AND THE LIKE IN SIAYAN, ZAMBOANGA DEL NORTE.

Prefatory Statement

Under Section 129 of RA 7160 provides the Local Government Unit to exercise its power to create its own sources of revenues and to levy taxes and charges.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Honorable Sangguniang Bayan in session assembled:

SECTION I. TITLE: This ordinance shall be known as "An ordinance prescribing rules and regulations of the transport permit from the office of the Municipal Mayor on the Natural resources like mineral ore, sand and gravel, soils, guano and the like in the municipality of Siayan, Zamboanga del Norte.

SECTION II. DECLARATION OF POLICY: All natural resources within the jurisdiction of Siayan, Province of Zamboanga del Norte explored, extracted, quarried and the like be transported to another places by a person or group of persons, investors, contractors, mining corporations and the like will secure transportal permit from the office of the Municipal Mayor, corresponding fees:

SECTION III. PENAL PROVISIONS: Any person or group of persons, investors, contractors, mining corporations and the like that will violate this ordinance shall be penalized a fines of not more than five thousands (75,000,00) pesos or an imprisonment of 15 days but not more than 60 days or both fines and

imprisonment in the descretion of the Honorable Court upon conviction.

SECTION IV. This ordinance shall take effect after 30 days upon its approval, posting of copies to conspicuous places and publication.
