MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 99-005
Series of 1999

AN ORDINANCE PRESCRIBING RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE TRANSPORT PERMIT
FROM THE OFFICE OF THE MUNICIPAL MAYOR ON THE NATURAL RESOURCES LIKE MINERAL
ORE, SAND AND GRAVEL, SOILS AND GUANO, MAJOR AND MINOR FOREST AND THE LIKE
IN SIAYAN, ZAMBOANGA DEL NORTE.

Prefatory Statement

Under Section 129 of RA 7160 provides the Local Government Unit to
exercise its power to create its own sources of revenues and to levy taxes
and charges.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Honorable Sangguniang Bayan in session assembled:

SECTION I. TITLE: This ordinance shall be known as "An ordinance pres-
cribing rules and regulations of the transport permit from the office of the
Municipal Mayor on the Natural resources like mineral ore, sand and gravel,
soils, guano and the like in the municipality of Siayan, Zamboanga del Norte.

SECTION II. DECLARATION OF POLICY: All natural resources within the ju-
risdiction of Siayan, Province of Zamboanga del Norte explored, extracted,
quarried and the like be transported to another places by a person or group
of persons, investors, contractors, mining corporations and the like will
secure transportal permit from the office of the Municipal Mayor, correspon-
ding fees:

1. Mineral Ore	₱5.00 per ton
2. Sand and gravel	1.00 per ton
3. Soil filling materials	1.00 per ton
4. Lumber	1.00 per ton
5. Rattan	.50 per ton
6. Ornamental plants/orchids/gantao	1.00 each
7. Guano	5.00 per sack
8. Birds all kinds	2.00 each
9. Wild Animals (all kinds)	5.00 each

SECTION III. PENAL PROVISIONS: Any person or group of persons, investors,
contractors, mining corporations and the like that will violate this ordinance
shall be penalized a fines of not more than five thousands (₱5,000.00) pesos
or an imprisonment of 15 days but not more than 60 days or both fines and

imprisonment in the descretion of the Honorable Court upon conviction.

SECTION IV. This ordinance shall take effect after 30 days upon its approval, posting of copies to conspicuous places and publication.

SECTION I. This Ordinance shall be known as the Ordinance Prohibiting the Large Cattle Owners from bringing their animals to pass along the municipal street and/or highway without allowing them to bring along with them a person or any kind for the safety of their animals.

SECTION II. The purpose of this Ordinance is to maintain the cleanliness of the municipal street and/or highway from the animals, dogs, cats, birds, etc. and to prevent the animals from bringing their animals to the street and/or highway without allowing them to bring along with them a person or any kind for the safety of their animals.

SECTION III. PENALTIES AND

a) Owners/riders bringing their animals, dogs, cats, birds, etc. to the street and/or highway without allowing them to bring along with them a person or any kind for the safety of their animals shall be fined the sum of five hundred (500) pesos and/or imprisonment for the same period of time as the animals are brought along with them.
