**"MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 10-11
Series of 2010**

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING "VOLUNTARY BLOOD DONATION PROGRAM" UNDER REPUBLIC ACT 7719 KNOWN AS NATIONAL VOLUNTARY BLOOD SERVICES ACT OF 1994."

EXPLANATORY NOTE

WHEREAS, it is "An Act Promoting Voluntary Blood Donation, Providing for an adequate Supply of Safe Blood, Regulating Blood Bank, and Providing Penalties for violation thereof."

WHEREAS, this is an enabling ordinance establishing the Municipal/Barangay Blood Councils and Prescribing the Rules and Regulations for its effective implementation in the Municipality of Siayan.

WHEREAS, in case of emergency people of Siayan spend their last centavo for procuring blood donors or buying commercial blood to save their loved ones life.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Sangguniang Bayan of Siayan that:

ARTICLE I

SECTION I. TITLE – This ordinance shall be known as the **"Municipal and Barangay Blood Council Ordinance."**

ARTICLE II

SECTION 2 – There shall be created the Municipal and Barangay Blood Councils in the Municipality of Siayan, Zamboanga del Norte to institutionalize the provisions of Republic Act 7719 otherwise known as the National Blood Services Act 1994, and to fully implement DILG Memorandum Circular No. 96-6.

SECTION 3 – The Local Health Board shall be the policy making body of the Municipal/Barangay Blood Councils. It shall constitute a committee to oversee and implement the Municipal Voluntary Blood Donation Program (MVBDP). It shall have the following functions:

1. Formulate the Municipal Voluntary Blood Donation Program (MVBDP) strategic plan;
2. Operate the Barangay Blood Councils in coordination with the respective barangays in the Municipality;
3. Establish the Municipal Mobile Blood Collecting Team;
4. Monitor and evaluate the MVBDP Programs;
5. Incorporate into the strategic plan programs such as but not limited to information and education, medical services, blood donor recruitment retention/care, blood typing, blood collecting facilities, monitoring and evaluation;
6. Identify and train barangay coordinators who shall hence be named Barangay Blood Program Coordinators and who shall make operational the Barangay Blood Councils;
7. Generate multi-sectoral support for the MVBDP and the Barangay Blood Councils;
8. Conduct meetings, trainings, seminars and orientations on the MVBDP.

ARTICLE III

COMPOSITION OF THE MUNICIPAL/BARANGAY BLOOD COUNCILS

SECTION 4 – The Municipal Blood Councils shall be composed of the Municipal Mayor as Chairman and Municipal Health Officer as Co-Chairman who shall appoint a Municipal Blood Program Coordinator with members: Sangguniang Bayan Chairman Committee on Health, Department of Health and various sectors to be appointed by the chairman.

SECTION 5 – The Barangay Blood Councils shall be composed of the following: a Barangay Blood Program Coordinator who shall be named by the Barangay Chairman. A Chairman must necessarily be a Barangay Official and five (5) members which must come from the various sectors in a particular community to be appointed by the Barangay Council upon the recommendation of the Barangay Chairman.

SECTION 6 – All members of the Municipal/Barangay Blood Council must undergo training and orientation on the Voluntary Blood Donation Program.

SECTION 7 – The Municipal/Barangay Blood Councils shall determine its internal rules and regulations.

ARTICLE IV

FUNCTIONS OF THE MUNICIPAL/BARANGAY BLOOD COUNCILS

SECTION 8 – The Municipal Blood Council shall serve as the umbrella of all Blood Councils in the Municipality and shall have the following functions:

1. Coordinate with the different Blood Councils related to Blood Program activities in the Municipality;
2. Source out and collect funds for the Blood Program (IEC materials, advocacy campaigns, trainings, seminars) from local and foreign donors;
3. Provide trainings/seminars on Voluntary Blood Donations;
4. Monitor and evaluate different Barangay Councils in the Municipality.

SECTION 9 – The Barangay Blood Council shall have the following functions:

1. Prepare for the conduct of regular blood activities of the barangay;
2. Conduct barangay level information and education campaigns on Voluntary Blood Donations;
3. Maintain a master list of Voluntary Blood Donors in the barangay;
4. Safely deliver collected blood to the Blood Center for laboratory testing; and
5. Refer clients to the Blood Center for subsequent release of requested blood.

ARTICLE V

FUNCTIONS OF THE MUNICIPAL BLOOD COLLECTING TEAM

SECTION 10 – The Municipal Blood Collecting Team after it has been established by the Municipal Health Office, shall have the following functions:

1. Assist Barangay Blood Councils in identifying target groups for blood donation;
2. Assist the Barangay Blood Council in recruiting and screening (physical exams, weight, blood pressure check, hemoglobin and blood typing) potential blood donors;
3. Assist the two (2) blood service facilities during the conduct of barangay blood donations;
4. Assist the Barangay Blood Council in the conduct of pre and post donation counseling (donor retention, care and recall);
5. Document and maintain record of blood activities conducted.

ARTICLE VI APPROPRIATION

SECTION 11 - A substantial amount of ONE HUNDRED THOUSAND PESOS (P100,000.00) shall be appropriated to cover the production of IEC materials, trainings, seminars, monitorings, and supplies needed by the Blood Councils (Municipal and 22 Barangays) and other such paraphernalia in the conduct of blood typing and blood donation.

ARTICLE VII FINAL PROVISIONS


SECTION 12 – SEPARABILITY CLAUSE – If for any reason, any section or provision on this Ordinance is declared unconstitutional or invalid, the other sections or provisions hereof which are not affected thereby shall continue to be in force and effect.

SECTION 13 – REPEALING CLAUSE – All Ordinances, local issuance or rules inconsistent with provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.


SECTION 14 – EFFECTIVITY CLAUSE – This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon approval.
