## MEASURES APPROVED IN THE THIRD AND FINAL READING

## ORDINANCE NO. 96-016 Series of 1996

DECLARING EVERY FIRST WEDNESDAY OF OCTOBER, 1996 AND EVERY YEAR THEREAFTER AS SUBANEN TRIBAL DAY DELEBRATION.

## AUTHORED BY HON. DESIDERIO C. ROMERO

BE IT ORDAINED by the Honorable Sangguniang Bayan of Siayan, Zamboanga del Norte in session assembled:

- SECTION 1. a. TITLE this ordinance shall be known as AN ORDINANCE DECLARING EVERY FIRST WEDNESDAY OF OCTOBER, 1996 AND EVERY YEAR THEREAFTER AS SUBANEN TRIBAL DAY CELEBRATION.
- B. SCOPE this ordinance shall cover all the barangays within the jurisdiction of the municipality of Siayan, Zamboanga del Norte.
- SECTION 2. DEFINITION OF SUBANEN TRIBAL TERMS: When used in this erdinance:
- a. DATU refers to the overall tribal chief who performs: administrative and other duties to include legal aspects.
- b. TIMOAY LARE a subsmen tribal chieftain or priest in the sanicipal level.
- c. TIMOAY refers to a subanon tribal head or priest in the barangay level.
- d. SALILING refers to a subanen tribal religious leader who performs the tribal wedding.
  - e. KINES/DAGA means a subanen tribal weddings
  - f. LILIMBAKEN/LIEUBAKAN refers to a subanen tribal dance.
- g. BOKIOS refers to a subanan thanksgiving festival highlighted by group dancing in the beklegan.
- h. AGONG a round, wheel-like metal with a protruging center and an open back which produce sound when banged.
- i/ KULINTANG a musical instrument; a row of agongs in different sixes arranged from biggest to smallest played with two bamboos sticks in each hand of the player.
- j. BEBOIC a communication! language and /or signal with the
- k. KUTAPI refers to a musical instrument made of wood and two strings.
- l. BOKLOGAN a high-legged stage with cradling fleer where a center pole banged a gong placed below the center stage.

SECTION 3. DECLARATION OF POLICY:

- It is the pelicy of the present administration of the local government of Siayan, Zamboanga del Norte to give due respect and honor to the subanen tribe who composes the majority of the population.
- b. That subanen customs and traditions shall be preserved, and that their leaders such as datu, timoay, saliling be recognized.
- c. That every first Wednesday of October shall be considered a significant day for the subanens and for them to freely enjoy and participate in all subanen activities on the day of the celebration.
- d. That during the celebration, ritual activities such as daga, boklog, etc. shall be the highlight, and encourage the participants to wear the subanen costume and accesories.
- SECTION 4. ORDAINING CLAUSE. That every first Wednesday of October every year is hereby declared as "SUBANEN TRIBAL DAY".
- SECTION 5. REPEALING CLAUSE. All ordinances, rules and regulations inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed and modified accordingly.
- SECTION 6. EFFECTIVITY CLAUSE. That this ordinance shall take effect Thirty (30) days after approval and publication of copies by posting in conspicuous places, publishing in newspapers of general circulation and furnishing to all concerned.

Approved Unanimously.

There being no further business before the Sanggamiang Bayan of Siayan in session assembled, thus, the regular session adjourned at 5:00 e'clock in the afternoon, moved by Hon. Felicisimo E. Dompales, duly seconded by all the rest SB Members present.
