MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE AMENDING MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 04-005 SERIES OF 2004 RECLASSIFYING A PORTION OF AGRICULTURAL LAND INTO RESIDENTIAL LAND, MEASURING ONE (1) HECTARE LOCATED AT DIONGAN, SIAYAN, ZAMBOANGA DEL NORTE IDENTIFIED AS LOT A, PORTION OF LOT 7 & 9, PCS-097218-001228 PART OF TITLE NO. T-17229 REGISTERED IN THE NAME OF SALVADOR LIMBANG.

PREFATORY STATEMENT

This body had acted Municipal Ordinance No. 04-005, Series of 2004, reclassifying a portion of agricultural land measuring one (1) hectare located at barangay Diongan of this municipality, identified as Lot A, a portion of Lot 7 & 9 PCS-097218-001228 part of Title No. T-17229 with an area of Ten (10) hectares, registered in the name of Salvador P. Limbang.

Behind the knowledge of the Sangguniang Bayan and some offices concerned on its reclassification, said agricultural land was surveyed and sub-divided among the children the legal heirs of Salvador P. Limbang. Presently, as per record in the Office of the Municipal Assessor, the aforecited portion of agricultural land has its new documents with corresponding number bearing Lot. No. 4809-10, measuring .4487 hectares and Lot No. 4809-9, measuring 2.461 hectares now registered in the name of Elsa A. Limbang.

The effectivity of Municipal Ordinance No. 04-005, Series of 2004 is inconsistent to the present documents of the said portion of agricultural land, hence shall be amended, stated hereunder, as amended:

BE IT ORDAINED by the Sangguniang Bayan of Siayan, Zamboanga del Norte in session assembled:

SECTION 1. TITLE. This shall be known as “ AN ORDINANCE RECLASSIFYING A PORTION OF AGRICULTURAL LAND INTO RESIDENTIAL LAND, MEASURING ONE (1) HECTARE LOCATED AT DIONGAN, SIAYAN, ZN IDENTIFIED AS LOT NO. 4809-10, MEASURING .4487 HECTARES, ARP NO. 021300600912 AND LOT NO. 4809-9, MEASURING 2.461 HECTARES, ARP NO. 02130060920 REGISTERED IN THE NAME OF ELSA P. LIMBANG AMENDING MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 04-005, SERIES OF 2004”



**SECTION II. ORDAINING CLAUSE.** That Lot No. 4809-10, measuring .4487 hectares, declared under ARP No. 021300600912 and Lot No. 4809-9, measuring 2.461 hectares, declared under ARP No. 02130060920 in the Office of the Municipal Assessor of this municipality, registered in the name of Elsa P. Limbang is hereby reclassified into residential land.

**SECTION III. EFFECTIVITY.** This Ordinance shall take effect upon approval of the Hon. Sangguniang Panlalawigan of Zamboanga del Norte, publication of copies in official gazette and posting at conspicuous places.

RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE HON. PROVINCIAL GOVERNOR AURORA ENERIO CERILLES OF ZAMBOANGA DEL SUR TO CANCEL THE SMALL-SCALE MINING CONCESSION PERMIT OF ENGR. CRESENTE Y. LLORENTE JR. UNDER PERMIT NO. 05-0001, DATED DECEMBER 10, 2004.

WHEREAS, the VILLOR Chrome mining firm, owned by Engr. Cresente Y. Llorente was operating in barangay Gunyan, Municipality of Siayan, Province of Zamboanga del Norte, started sometime on the year 1987 up to the present;

WHEREAS, Just recently, the Police force of this municipality intercepted an unregistered hauling trucks, loaded with chromite ore owned by the VILLOR mining corporation, eventually mining permit and transport permit was presented, surprisingly, it was noted that the Governor's Permit was issued by Hon. Governor Aurora Enerio Cerilles of Zamboanga del Sur.

WHEREAS, the issuance of Smali-Scale Concession Mining Permit by Hon. Governor Aurora Enerio Cerilles was misrepresented and improper since there's no such barangay Seriak of Dumingag Zamboanga del Sur, and actually the chromite mining site is not in barangay Seriak, however it is within Barangay Gunyan of Siayan, Zamboanga del Norte.

WHEREAS, Seriak is a component barangay upon the creation of the municipality of Siayan, Zamboanga del Norte by virtue of RA 4989 known as "An Act Creating the Municipality of Siayan in the Province of Zamboanga del Norte". (Photocopy of RA 4989 is hereto attached)

WHEREFORE, premise of the foregoing consideration, and on motion of Hon. Oliver A. Romero, duly seconded by all members present, it was

RESOLVED, as this body hereby resolved to request the Hon. Provincial Governor of Zamboanga del Sur Aurora Enerio Cerilles to cancel the Small-Scale Mining Concession Permit issued by her good office to Cresente Y. Llorente Jr. under Permit No. 05-0001, dated December 10, 2004.

RESOLVED FURTHER, to request the Hon. Governor Cerilles to conduct ocular inspection/verification of the aforecited mining site.

RESOLVED FINALLY, to furnish copies of this resolution to the Hon. Governor Rolando E. Yebe, DENR, Mines and Geosciences Bureau, Regional Office No. 9, Zamboanga City for information, reference and appropriate action.

“MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 05-03  
Series of 2005

MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE CREATING THE LOCAL YOUTH DEVELOPMENT COUNCIL OF THE  
MUNICIPALITY OF SIAYAN, ZAMBOANGA DEL NORTE AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Honorable Sangguniang Bayan of Siayan, Zamboanga del Norte in session assembled, that:

**SECTION I. TITLE:** This Ordinance shall be known as the "Local Youth Development Council Ordinance" of the municipality of Siayan, Zamboanga del Norte.



**SECTION II. DECLARATION OF POLICY:** It is deemed policy of the municipality to promote and protect the physical, moral, spiritual, intellectual and social well-being of Filipino Youth, inculcating in them patriotism and nationalism and encourage their involvement in public and civic affairs.

**SECTION III. DEFINITION OF TERMS:** As used in this Ordinance, the following terms shall mean:

1. **Youth** – refers to those persons whose ranges from fifteen (15) to thirty (30) years as provided under Republic Act 8044.
2. **In-School Youth** – refers to youth attending either formal schools or non-school-based educational programs under institutions recognized by the State.
3. **Out-of-School-Youth** – refers to youth not enrolled in any formal or vocational school, not employed or self-employed and are not college or technical/vocational school graduates.
4. **Working Youth** – refers to youth who are either employed, self-employed, underemployed or belong to specific employable job seeking youth groups (such as graduates of tertiary and vocational schools, or those who previously were employed and are actively looking for work) both in formal and informal sectors of the society.
5. **Youth with Special Needs** – refers to youth marginalized by existing societal forces, namely: youth in indigenous cultural communities, youth with disabilities, youth in situations of armed conflict, victims of natural disasters and calamities, youth offenders, delinquent youth, drug-dependent youth, street youth, abused/exploited youth, and abandoned/neglected youth.

**SECTION IV. LOCAL YOUTH DEVELOPMENT COUNCIL:** There shall be created a Local Youth Development Council which shall be responsible for the formulation of policies and implementation of youth development programs, projects and activities in coordination with various government and non-government organizations.

**SECTION V. OBJECTIVES:** Local Youth Development Councils shall have the following objectives:

**General Objectives:**

- a) To develop and harness the full potential of the youth as responsible partners in nation-building;
- b) To encourage intensive and active participation of youth in all government and non-government programs, projects and activities affecting them;
- c) To normalize all government and non-government initiatives for the development of the youth sector, and
- d) To supplement government appropriations for youth promotion and development with funds from other sources.

**Specific Objectives:**

- a) To broaden and strengthen the services provided by the national government agencies, local government units and private agencies to young people.
- b) To provide information mechanism on youth opportunities on the areas of education, employment, livelihood, physical and mental health, capability-building and networking.
- c) To increase the spirit of voluntarism among the youth of the city/municipality particularly in the maintenance of peace and order and preservation, conservation and protection of the environment and natural resources within the locality.
- d) To provide monitoring and coordinating mechanisms for youth programs, projects and activities, and
- e) To provide a venue for the active participation of the youth in cultural and eco-tourism awareness program.

**SECTION VI. COMPOSITION OF THE COUNCIL:** The Council shall be composed of the following:

Mr. Sixto S. Atuy, Jr. (MPDC)  
Mr. Ruben Anthony B. Quebral (DILG Officer)  
Ms. Editha L. Pasinabo (DSWD Officer)  
Dr. Raymund P. Nadela MD (Municipal Health Officer)  
Dr. Bezer B. Crampatanta (PICD)  
Hon. Janina Elise T. Siasico (SK Fed. Pres.)  
Mr. Roberto G. Gabato (Catholic Youth Ministry President, Roman Catholic)  
Ms. Jenny H. Villalon (Christian Youth Fellowship President, UCCP)  
Mr. Antonio C. Bermejo (Sports Development Officer)



**SECTION VII. FUNCTION OF THE LOCAL YOUTH DEVELOPMENT COUNCIL:** The following shall be the functions of the Local Youth Development Council:

- a) To formulate policies and component programs in coordination with the various government agencies handling youth-related programs, projects and activities;
- b) To coordinate and harmonize activities of all agencies and organizations in the city/municipality engaged in youth development programs;
- c) To develop and provide support for the development and coordination of youth projects and design strategies to gain support and participation of the youth;
- d) To accredit sports and recreational centers, hostels, training centers and other institutions providing services to the youth as identified in the Ordinance.
- e) To assist the national government agencies, in the promotion of programs, projects and activities in the local level;
- f) To assist various government and non-government agencies, in the identification and nomination of qualified participants to different programs, projects and activities;
- g) To conduct fund raising programs and solicitations. It shall likewise received donations bequests and may enter into contracts with other government and non-government agencies necessary for the accomplishment of the objectives of this act;
- h) To recommend youth programs and project proposals to appropriate government agencies and non-government organizations;
- i) To recommend youth programs and project proposals to appropriate government agencies and non-government organizations of this ordinance;
- j) To accredit training pools for the purpose of assisting line agencies in implementing training and capability programs;
- k) To solicit books and receive donations from any individual, non-government agencies, both local and international;
- l) To create a research team that will formulate a mechanism to come up with a Local Youth Situationer;
- m) To established youth center as deemed necessary;
- n) To monitor implementation of programs and projects at the local level;
- o) To nominate its delegate to National Youth Parliament; and
- p) Perform such other functions as may be provided by law.

**SECTION VIII. LOCAL YOUTH DEVELOPMENT PLAN:** The Council shall formulate and adopt a 5-Year/Municipality Youth Development Plan which shall duly supported by an Ordinance enacted by the Sangguniang Pambayan. The said plan shall be the basis for the implementation of Local Youth Development Program and Services in coordination with concerned agencies. These shall include but not limited to Youth Development Program and Youth Development Services.

**SECTION IX. YOUTH CENTER:** The Council may establish a youth center, which shall be located in the municipality proper. The Youth Center shall operate as a multi-purpose center and a One-Stop Shop Facility.

**SECTION X. MEETINGS OF THE COUNCIL:** The Council shall meet at least once a month or as often as may be deemed necessary. The Chairman or his duly designated convenor shall preside in all Council Meetings.

**SECTION XI. DISCOUNT PRIVILEGES:** To inculcate in the youth, the ideals of self-development in areas of education, arts, culture, sports and recreation, the youth shall be granted discounts/privileges as follows:

- a) Ten Percent (10%) discount from transportation services provided by public transport vehicles in the city/municipality.
- b) A maximum of Ten Percent (10%) discount from hotels and seminar lodging establishments, recreations and sports centers in the city/municipality
- c) A minimum of Ten Percent (10%) discount on admission fees charge by theaters, concert halls, museums, parks, and other similar places of culture arts, history of education in the city/municipality.

Private establishments in the city/municipality that provide the said discounts may claim cost as stock deduction as defined under Section 13 of this Ordinance for purposes of this section however, only the youth whose age ranges from Fifteen (15) to twenty one (21) years shall be entitled to discounts privileges.

**SECTION XII. YOUTH IDENTIFICATION CARDS:** To avail of the services and discounts in the municipality, the council shall issue Youth Identification Cards. Provided, that the Council may designate a Committee that shall evaluate and process the application forms. Qualified Youth Cardholders shall present their individual Community Tax Certificate as a requirement for the issuance of their Identification Cards and may be required to pay the actual cost of the Identification Cards.

**SECTION XIII. TAX INCENTIVES TO MUNICIPALITY ESTABLISHMENTS:** Local private establishments in the municipality that provide the discounts as mentioned in this Ordinance may claim the cost as Tax Deductions.



**SECTION XIV. APPROPRIATIONS:** There is hereby authorize appropriations for the establishment of the Local Youth Development Council which shall be appropriated next budgeting year to be embodied in the Annual Budget CY 2006.


**SECTION XV. EFFECTIVITY CLAUSE:** This Ordinance shall take effect within Thirty (30) days from its approval.




Since there being no further business before the Hon. Sangguniang Bayan in session assembled thus the regular adjourned at 5:00 O'clock in the afternoon.


