MESSAGE OF THE PUNONG BARANGAY

The signing of Executive Order No. 138 by President Rodrigo R. Duterte is a big milestone on the part of Local Government units in realizing the full devolution of powers and resources as mandated by the 1991 Local Government Code. With the Mandanans-Garcia Ruling of the supreme Court, LGUs are now granted a just share in national taxes consistent with the policy of decentralization as enshrined in the constitution.

We welcome this development and anticipate its positive impact in terms of empowering LGUs to deliver basic services, which are responsive to the needs of the people. We understand that the financial resources of an LGU are directly proportional to its responsibilities. In other words, increase in financial resources would mean an increase in powers, authority , and responsibilities of the LGU.

The creation of the Devolution Transition Committee (DTC) at the barangay level has been instrumental in accelerating the actions of the barangay to comply with the requirements of the EO 138 as well as those contained in the Department of Budget and Management and the Department of the Interior and Local Government Joint Memorandum Circular re "Guidelines on the preparation of Devolution Transition Plans of Local Government Units in Support of Devolution, under Executive Order No. 138, dated 01 of June 2021" dated august 11, 2021.

With the guidance of the Municipal Government of Siayan, Zamboanga del Norte and the Department of the Interior and Local Government Siayan field Office, we were able to formulate this Barangay devolution Transition Plan despite resource limitations and the restrictions brought about by the COVID-19 pandemic.

I thank all the individuals who have generously offered their time, talent, insights, hard work, sacrifices, and commitment in the accomplishment of this Devolution Transition Plan.

Let as work together in the realization of our common goals and objectives as we journey to become a more efficient and effective Barangay Gonayen under the full devolution.

EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 01 S. 2021

ORGANIZATION OF BARANGAY DEVOLUTION TRANSITION COMMITTEE (DTC)

WHEREAS, Pursuant to Section 2 (a) of Republic Act (RA) No. 7160 of the Local Government Code of 1991 (LGC) the state shall provide for a more responsive and accountable local government structure instituted through a system of decentralization whereby Local Government Units (NGUs) shall be given more powers, authority, responsibilities and resources. The process of decentralization shall proceed from the National Government (NG) to the LGUs;

WHEREAS, Section 3 (d) of RA NO. 7160 further provides that the vesting of duty, responsibility, and accountability in LGUs shall be accompanied with provision for reasonably adequate resources to discharge their powers and effectively carry out their functions; hence, they shall have the power to create and broaden their own sources of revenue and the right to a just share in national taxes and an equitable share in the proceeds of the utilization and development of the national wealth within their respective areas;

WHEREAS, The Supreme Court (SC) decision in the consolidated cases og Congressman Hermilando I. Mandanas, et al. vs. Executive Secretary Paquito N. Ochoa, Jr. et al. and Honorable Enrique T. Garcia, Jr. vs. Executive Secretary Paquito Ochoa, et al. 2 clarifies the basis for the computation of local government shares and ordered the NG to include all collections of national taxes in the computation of the base amount for the just share of the LGUs. This is pursuant to section 6, Article X of the 1987 Philippine Constitution which provides that the LGUs shall have a just share in the National taxes which shall be automatically released to them;

WHEREAS, In line with the implementation of the SC Ruling, Executive (EC) No. 138,s. 2021 orders the full devolution of functions, services, and facilities by the NG to the LGUs not later than the end of FY 2024. Except for those functions that shall continue to be shared with the NG pursuant to the guiding principles enumerated under EO No. 138, s. 2021 and its IRR, starting FY 2022, the LGUs shall be primarily and ultimately responsible and accountable for the provision of all basis services and facilities fully devolved to them, in accordance with the minimum standards for service delivery to be prescribed by the NG.

WHEREAS, to support transition to full devolution, Section 10 of EO No. 138, s. 2021 and its Implementing Rules and Regulation instructs all LGUs to formulate and prepare Devolution Transition Plan (DTPs) to guide the Transition in their full assumption of the devolved roles and responsibilities;

WHEREAS, The LGU DTP preparation shall be undertaken in close coordination with the NGAs concerned, especially with regard to devolved functions and services critical to them. The provinces, cities, municipalities and barangays to organize the LGU Devolution Transition Committee (LGU) DTC) which shall be responsible for the preparation of the LGU DTP and in monitoring the implementation thereof;

NOW THEREFORE, I, Hon. Allan V. Anggay, by the powers vested in me by law as the Punong Barangay of Gonayen, Municipality of Siayan, Zamboanga del Norte, do hereby organize the Devolution transition Committee to compose of the following:

Section 1. COMPOSITION - The composition of the Barangay Devolution Transition Committee shall be the following:

Section 2. FUNCTIONS – The Barangay Devolution Transition Committee (DTC) shall be responsible for the preparation of the LGU DTP and in the monitoring the implementation thereof.

Section 3. CONTENTS OF THE LGU DEVOLUTION TRANSITION PLAN - the Barangay Devolution shall be comprised of the following attachments:

A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE DEVOLUTION TRANSITION PLAN OF BARANGAY GONAYEN, SIAYAN, ZAMBOANGA DEL NORTE PROVIDING THE BARANGAY GOVERNMENT WITH A ROADMAP TO ENSURE STRATEGIC, SYSTEMATIC AND COHERENT ACTIONS TOWARDS THE FULL IMPLEMENTATION OF FUNCTIONS, SEVICES AND FACILITIES TO BE FULLY DEVELOVED BY NATIONAL GOVERNMENT AGENCIES (NGA'S) CONCERNED, STARTING FY 2022.

WHEREAS, Section 25, Article II of the constitution provides that the state shall insure the autonomy of local governments;

WHEREAS, Section 6 Article X of the Constitution provides that Local Government Units (LGUs) shall have a just share, as determined by law, in the National Taxes which shall automatically release to them;

WHEREAS, Section II (a) of the Local Government Code (LGC) of 1991 (Republic act No. 7160) provide that the state shall provide for more responsive and accountable local government structure instituted through a system of decentralization whereby Local Government Units (LGU's) shall be given more powers authority, responsibilities and resources. The process of decentralization shall proceed from the national government (NG) to the Local Government Units (LGUs);

WHEREAS, Section 3 (d) of the LGC further provides that "the vesting of duty, responsibility and accountability in Local Government Units shall be accompanied with provision for reasonably adequate resources to discharge their powers and effectively carry out their functions; hence, they shall have the power to create and broaden their own sources of revenue and the right to a just share in National Taxes and an equitable share in the proceeds of the utilization and development of the national wealth within their respective areas";

WHEREAS, The Supreme Court (SC) decision in the consolidated cases of the Congressman Hermilando I. Mandanas, et al. vs. executive Secretary Paquito N. Ochoa, Jr. et al. and Honorable Enrique T. Garcia, Jr. vs. Executive Secretary Paquito Ochoa, et al. y clarifies the basis for the computation of local government shares and ordered the national government to include all connections national taxes in the computation of the base amount for the just share on LGUs;

WHEREAS, Executive Order No. 138,s. 2021 orders the full devolution of functions, services, and facilities by the National Government (NG) to Local Government Unit (LGUs) no later than the end of FY 2024. These shall include those devolved responsibilities indicated in Section 17 of RA 7160 and in other existing laws which subsequently devolved functions of the NG to LGUs. These fully devolved responsibilities shall be funded from the share of the LGUs in the proceeds of the national taxes and other local revenues;

WHEREAS, Section 10 of Executive Order No. 138, s.2021 orders all local governments to prepare their Devolution Transition Plan (DTPs) in close coordination with the NGAs concerned especially with regard to devolved functions and services that are critical to them;

WHEREAS, the DBM-DILG Joint Memorandum Circular (JMC) No. 2021-1 required all LGUs to prepare their DPPs to ensure a dated strategic perspective and systematic and coherent actions towards their full assumption of devolved functions and services starting in FY 2022;

NOW THEREFORE, on motion of honorable Jane O. Pacarat duly seconded by the majority of the members present, it was:

BE IT RESOLVED, as it is resolved by the Sangguniang Barangay of Gonayen, Siayan, Zamboanga del Norte to approved the Devolution Transition Plan providing the Barangay Government with a roadmap to ensure strategic, systematic, and coherent actions towards the full implementation of functions services, and facilities to be fully devolve by national government agencies concerned starting in FY 2022;

RESOLVED, further, that copies of this Resolution be furnish to the Municipal Government of Siayan, Zamboanga del Norte, the members of the Devolution transition Committee, the Sangguniang barangay of Gonayen, Siayan, Zamboanga del Norte, NGAs concerned and the local office of DILG.

SECTION 1. STATE OF DEVOLVED FUNCTIONS, SERVICES AND FACILITIES FOR BARANGAYS

Section 17 of Republic Act No. 7160 or the Local Government Code of 1991 provides the Local Government units shall endeavour to be self-reliant and shall continue exercising the powers and discharging the duties and functions currently vested upon them. They shall also discharge the functions and responsibilities of national agencies and offices devolved to them pursuant to this Code. Local government units shall likewise exercise such other powers and discharge such other functions and responsibilities as are necessary, appropriate, or incidental to efficient and effective provision of the basic services and facilities.

Such basic services and facilities for Barangays include, but are not limited to, the following:

- Agriculture support services which include planting materials distribution system and operation of farm produce collection and buying stations;
- Health and social welfare services which include maintenance of Barangay Health Center and Day-care Center;
- Services and facilities related to general hygiene and sanitation, beautification, and solid waste collection;
- Maintenance of Katarungang Pambarangay
- Maintenance of Barangay roads and bridges and water supply systems
- Infrastructure facilities such as multi-purpose hall, multi-purpose pavement, plaza sports center, and other similar facilities;
- Information and reading center; and
- · Satellite or public market, where viable.

After the enactment of the Local Government Code of 1991, barangays were also given additional functions and responsibilities through the passage of the following laws, to wit:

- Republic Act No. 9003 or the Ecological Solid Waste Management Act of 2003;
- Republic Act No. 10742 or the Sangguniang Kabataan Reform Act of 2015;
- Republic Act No. 10121 Philippine Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Act of 2010:
- Executive Order No. 56 S. 2018 or the Effective Implementation of Emergency 911;
- Executive Order No. 12 S. 2017 or the Implementation of Responsible Parenthood and Reproductive Health at the LGUs;
- Republic Act No. 1344 or the Juvenile Justice and Welfare Act of 2006; and
- Republic Act No. 9275 or the Philippine clean Water Act of 2004.

In line with the implementation of the Supreme Court Ruling on Mandanas and Garcia Petitions, President Rodrigo R. Duterte issued Executive order No. 138 s. 2021 ordering full devolution of certain functions of the executive branch to local government units. In response, National Government Agencies (NGAs) formulated their respective Devolution Transition Plans to guide LGUs including barangays on what functions, services and facilities as well as specific programs, projects and activities to be devolved to them.

Based on our assessment, the following are the devolved functions, services and facilities currently implemented or existing in our barangay, to wit:

Programs/Projects/Activities

- 1. Maintenance of Barangay Roads and Bridges
- 2. Drying Pavement
- 3. Service and Facilities related to Beautification and Solid Waste collection
- 4. Practicing Solid Waste segregation (MRF)
- 5. Allocation of barangay funds for solid Waste Management programs and activities
- Maintenance of Barangay Health Stations and provision of Health Services 7 Facilities related to general hygiene and Sanitation & Mobilizing Volunteers
- 7. Construction of Health Center
- 8. Satellite of Public Market where viable
- 9. Maintenance of Katarungang Pambarangay
- 10. ECCD Early children Department
- 11. 1% BCPC Allocation of Funds
- 12. Maintenance of Registry of Barangay inhabitants
- 13. Every Collection of Taxes service fees or charges, barangay clearance and other fees charges that shall occur exclusively to the barangay

Also, the following are the devolved functions, services and facilities not yet implemented or not existing in our barangay, to wit:

- Agricultural Support services which include distribution system and operation of farm

 produce collection and buying stations
- 2. Quality Control of Copra
- 3. Information and Reading Center

Construction of Open Canal in Purok TIKAN I, and TIKAN II

The BLGU considers the community in Sitio Tikan I and Tikan II as the beneficiary for this significant project because the area is frequently flooded around the road every time during rainy season. The construction of the open canal allows rainwater to freely flow to a water gateway preventing possible flooding around the road in this two sitios and ensuring the safety and to avoid vehicular incident .

Of these devolved responsibilities, Barangay Gonayen considers the **establishment of the Barangay Nursery** as the priority program because the barangay recognizes the fact that financial support from the national government is not always available to all, and in order for the barangay to become self-sufficient especially under the COVID-19 pandemic, food security is very important. With the establishment of a nursery, the germination percentage (the likelihood for the new seedlings to propagate is high) and as a result, the barangay would be self-sufficient when it comes to food production. With the establishment of the nursery, the farmers will have a regular source of seedlings to ensure greater yield.

The devolved responsibilities implemented by the barangay are already making headways in term of delivering results in food production under the current pandemic.

- 1. Establishment of materials recovery facility
- 2. Enactment of policies pertaining to solid waste management from segregation of waste from source to actual waste disposal
- Issuance of resolution adopting solid waste management related policies enacted by the Sangguniang Bayan such as zero Policy, among others.

Under RA 9003, the barangays are primarily responsible for the effective and efficient solid waste management, particularly, garbage segregation and disposal. To comply with this mandate, Barangay Gonayen endeavours to establish materials recovery facility, enact policies pertaining to solid waste management, from segregation of waste from source to actual waste disposal, and to issue resolution adopting solid waste management related policies enacted by the Sangguniang Bayan such as zero Plastic Policy, among others.

The Barangay has already implemented the establishment of a materials recovery facility; however, the facility was damage due to recent typhoons. This barangay commits to rehabilitate the same and make it functional or operational starting this year onwards. As regards enactment of policies pertaining to solid waste management, this barangay had already issued the same in the past how ever, the lack of enforcement of this pieces of legislation was fatal.
