RESOLUTION EXPRESSING INTENT TO REQUEST 22 NURSES AND MIDWIVES TO BE ASSIGNED IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF SIAYAN, ZAMBOANGA DEL NORTE UNDER THE NURSE DEPLOYMENT PROGRAM (NDP) AND RURAL HEALTH MIDWIFE PLACEMENT PROGRAM (RHMPP) OF THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH (DOH).

WHEREAS, in pursuant to the devolution of Human Resource for Health (HRH) under the National Health Workforce Support System (NHWSS) of the Department of Health (DOH), Nurses and Midwives shall be deployed to the priority areas particularly the fifth (5th) and sixth (6th) class municipalities;

WHEREAS, the municipality of Siayan, ZN was declared as a third (3rd) class municipality, however considered as Geographically Isolated and Disadvantaged Areas (GIDA) considering that more or less 70% cultural minority (Subanen) in population, and the same time there are eight (8) barangays are under End Local Communist Armed Conflict (ELCAC);
